Austin Leong Wins County Spelling Bee, Now Headed to the Scripps National Spelling Bee

Austin Leong, a seventh grade student from Serrano Middle School, is the champion of the San Bernardino County Spelling Bee. The competition, involving 24 spellers from K-12 schools across San Bernardino County, lasted 49 rounds. Austin's winning word was "coalition."

This exceptional accomplishment has earned Austin a trip to Maryland, where he will compete in the Scripps National Spelling Bee. Despite the fact that Austin has won the Ontario-Montclair School District's annual Spelling Bee for four years in a row, competing in the Scripps Spelling Bee in Washington D.C. has been a goal of Austin's for many years.

The 2019 Scripps National Spelling Bee will be broadcast on ESPN channels on May 29-31, 2019. In addition to the all-expenses paid trip to the national finals for Austin and parent, he also won a free one-year subscription to Merriam-Webster Unabridged, a one-year membership to Britannica Online Premium, a 2019 U.S. Mint Proof Set, and a six-night stay at the Scripps National Spelling Bee's official hotel.
